On 24th February, the HPC Climate & Sustainability group held an interesting and highly informative 'Community Energy Day' in Chudleigh Knighton village hall.

A selection of speakers gave short talks throughout the afternoon that led into lively discussions on a variety of topics including; climate change, living with heat pumps, solar panels and batteries, local schemes for tackling fuel poverty / hard to heat homes and general energy advice.

There were demonstrations of using thermal cameras and how to build a wood fire in the most efficient way. There was also plenty of information available on how to reduce your carbon footprint and understanding climate change. Children were kept busy with fun activities and there was plenty of cake for all!
