**6<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 1944 – 2024**  
**80<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE D-DAY LANDINGS**



On 6<sup>th</sup> June 2024 Chudleigh Knighton will be marking the 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the D-day landings with the lighting of a Lamp of Peace at the village war memorial (gate arch to St Paul's Church); the event will commence at 9.05 p.m. and is anticipated to last for 20 minutes.

Come along and be part of celebrations that mark the historic turning point of World War II, when thousands of soldiers crossed the English Channel bound for beaches in Normandy. All are welcome, attendance is NOT restricted to residents of the village. The "Lamp Light Of Peace" is a traditional Oil Lantern. Its Ruby Red colouring represents the ultimate sacrifice made by brave men and women across the globe. The light from the flame will represent the 'light of peace' that emerged from the darkness of war.
